

2015-2017 S550 Mustang GT Cat Back Exhaust

Installation Instructions for Part #: 555-3615



Tools Needed

- 1. 15mm socket
- 2. 3/8" Ratchet
- 3. 3/8" drive 3" extension
- 4. 13mm socket
- 5. Safety glasses and gloves
- 6. Vehicle lift / jack and jack stands
- 7. Large flat head screw driver
- 8. Prying tool
- 9. Liquid soap or silicone spray.

Installation

- 1. Loosen OE band clamps connecting factory resonator to down pipes.
- 2. Use screwdriver to release pin securing resonator to OE down pipe. Twist and pull off each side.
- 3. Lube hangers with soap or silicone to prevent damage to rubber exhaust hangers.
- 4. Loosen bolts of rear hangers to facilitate removing exhaust
- 5. Slide entire exhaust assembly rearward with help from second person.
- 6. Transfer OE isolator and brackets to new exhaust.
- 7. Install provided clamps over each end of X-pipe and slide onto end of OE exhaust. Do not tighten clamps at this point.
- 8. Install clamps onto intermediate pipes and leave loose, do not tighten.
- 9. Install left & right intermediate pipe assemblies and install onto OE hangers, again to not tighten.
- 10.
- 11. Install clamps onto chrome tips and install on mufflers, do not tighten clamps.
- 12. Starting from front of car, align exhaust and tighten clamps working your way rearward.
- 13. Ensure tip ends are aligned in valence openings and the ends extend equidistant prior to tightening last band clamps.
- 14. Start vehicle and check for exhaust leaks with vehicle running parked. If leaks are found recheck pipe engagement and clamp tightness to 50-55 ftlbs..
- 15. Drive vehicle for short distance then check entire system for exhaust leaks.
